B.T.B.A QUALIFIED INSTRUCTORS and COACHES

1. The B.T.B.A has agreed that, as of **1st January 1999**, the British Tenpin Bowling Instructors Association will be amalgamated with the British Tenpin Bowling Instructors Federation, under the banner of the BTBIF.
2. In addition, the Sports Council recommended that the Governing Bodies of Sports should licence those involved in the instruction of young people. Unlicensed individuals will NOT be authorised to carry out such instruction.
3. To become a **Licensed** Instructor or Coach you need to complete the following Licence Application, additional copies of which may be obtained from the NAYBC Secretary or B.T.B.A. Head Office.
